- 1. Firefighting is an exciting and challenging profession. It can also be a highly stressful and extremely dangerous profession. The stress is clearly different than the stress found in civilian occupations.
- 2. These stresses and dangers impact families and significant others as well.

When we do not know how we feel, we miss valuable information that we need to make appropriate adjustments in life. - 9. The wildfires during this time, killed at least 29 people and more than 200,000 people were evacuated.
